Unpaid entries and entries without proof of payment will not be accepted.
A transfer order is not a proof of order.

Important: For valid application, the entry form must include a legible photocopy of both sides of pedigree - **this applies to all entered dogs. If not done so, the entry will not be accepted.**

A valid entry is considered only a fully paid entry subject to the prices above. If the entry is not paid until the closing date, it will be excluded. The exhibitors are bound to submit appropriate certificates if entering their dog into Working, Winner or Honour class. If not submitted, the dog will be reassigned to Open class.

Classes:

Minor Puppy	4 to 6 months
Puppy	6 to 9 months
Junior	9 to 18 months
Intermediate	15 to 24 months
Open	from 15 months no matter the titles and hunting tests the dog has gained
Working	from 15 months, submit working certificate
Winners	from 15 months, submit international or national champion certificate or the title of National Winner, Club Winner or Special Club Winner
Veteran	8 years and over
Honour	from 15 months, CAC not to be claimed, submit international or national champion certificate or the title of National Winner, Club Winner or Special Club Winner. A dog awarded Ex1 competes for the Best of Breed.

Titles and awards in the Breed Ring:

CAJC (Junior class), CAC, r.CAC (Intermediate, Open, Winner, Working), Club Winner – the best male and female in breed (dogs awarded with CAC in Intermediate, Open, Winner and Working class)

Titles awarded in the Main Ring in each breed:

BOJ – Best Junior of Breed

(The title is awarded to the best junior dog or bitch of the breed who were awarded CAJC).

BOV – Best Veteran of Breed

(Dog or bitch who were awarded Excellent 1 in Veteran Class)

BOB – Best of Breed

(Dog CAJC, bitch CAJC, best veteran dog (Ex 1 Veteran), best veteran bitch (Ex 1 Veteran), both Club Winners dog and bitch and both dog and bitch Ex 1 in Honour Class compete for this title)

BOS – Best of Opposite Sex

(Dog or bitch CAJC, best veteran dog (Ex 1 Veteran) or best veteran bitch (Ex 1 veteran), Club Winner dog or bitch, and dog or bitch Ex 1 in Honour Class of the opposite sex compete for the BOS title)

Note: Assigning these titles and awards cannot be claimed. Titles and awards may be awarded no matter the number of exhibited dogs. First four dogs awarded excellent or very good (or very promising and promising) are placed in each class.

Best Breeder's Group a group of minimum three and maximum five dogs/bitches from one breeder, at least out of two Dams, who were exhibited at the show. These dogs/bitches do not have to be owned by the breeder.

General conditions:

- The exhibition is accessible to males and females of all breeds registered in the books recognized by the FCI that reached the age required for class the day of the show. Imported dogs must have a Czech registered.

- Organizers are not responsible for damages caused by a dog or an exhibitor, for dog loss or death during the exhibition.
- It is forbidden to treat the dog at the show grounds using any substances or equipment. Only cutting, trimming, combing and brushing can be done. It is also forbidden to tie dog to the table at the show for a longer period of time.
- It is forbidden to expose dogs to a situation that could endanger their health or well-being.
- During the dog show, the owners have to supervise their dogs not to cause any damage to other dogs or people.
- The show is not open for females in season, females in the second half of pregnancy, nursing females, aggressive dogs, ill dogs or dogs suspicious of being ill or dogs in ownership of a person forbidden to exhibit dogs.
- Exhibitors are required to comply with the provisions of the Show Regulations of FCI and ČMKU, these propositions and the instructions of Show Committee, to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form.
- If the show does not take place due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the expenses.
- It is forbidden to sell puppies at the show.
- The exhibitor is bound to pay the fee also in case they do not take part in the show for any reason.

Protests:

- a) A protest against any judge decision made is not admissible.
- b) A protest can be submitted because of formal reasons such as violation of show regulations. The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of the double price of entry fee for the first dog at first closing date.
- c) If protest is considered to be unjustified, deposit belongs to the show organizer.
- d) A protest can be submitted only during the show.
- e) The Protest committee usually has three members. It consists of the Referee, the Show Director and one Judge. At shows with only one judge or only foreign judges appointed, the Protest Committee may only have two members. In this case, it consists of the Referee and the Show Director.
- f) A protest is discussed by the Committee in presence of the judge (organizer) who is involved in the protest. A written report on discussion and result will be made.
- g) A protest submitted after the show has ended (after finishing judging in all rings) cannot be accepted.

Veterinary conditions:

Dogs must have a pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies, following par. 1, letter. f) of the Veterinární zákon. Dogs from EU countries and the third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet conditions according the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003.

A notice for exhibitors:

The parking fee is not included in the entry fee.

Privacy policy: By submitting the entry form, the dog owner agrees with publishing their personal data in the catalogue, reports, diplomas, and official results and that it will be used for processing the show results. The dog owner and exhibitor also agrees with the fact that photos taken at the show may be used by the club and for advertising this exhibition.
