General regulations: The show is held in accordance with valid Regulations for FCI Dog Shows, and the ČMKU Show Regulations. In case the show is not held for force majeure or veterinary reasons, the entry fee will be used to pay for organisational expenses.

Other Main ring competitions in the ring of honour (not recorded in the pedigree)

Breeder's Group - a breeder can enter minimum three and maximum five dogs of one breed of his own breeding from different connections (minimum two different Dams or Sires), which were judged at the show. These dogs have to be in the breeder's ownership.

Progeny Group (a group of progeny of one Sire or Dam) - a competition for a group of minimum three and maximum five dogs with the same parents (Sire or Dam). These dogs do not have to be in the breeder's ownership, but they have to be judged at the show. The Sire or Dam do not have to be judged at the show.

Best Brace - a competition for a dog and a bitch of the same breed judged at this show in ownership of one person

Best Minor Puppy - dogs and bitches awarded Very promising 1 in Minor Puppy class take part in this competition

Best Puppy - dogs and bitches awarded Very promising 1 in Puppy class take part in this competition

Best Junior - BOJs of all breeds take part in this competition

Best of Honour Class - dogs and bitches awarded Excellent 1 in Honour class take part in this competition

Best Working Dog - dogs and bitches awarded Excellent 1, CAC in Working class take part in this competition

Best Veteran - dogs or bitches awarded BOV take part in this competition

Best in Show - dogs or bitches awarded BOB take part in this competition

Show regulations: Entered dogs have to meet all requirements in the schedule. Admitting the dog, exhibitor has to submit the following documents - original pedigree, pet passport or valid vaccination card. Club winner title may only be awarded to a dog in KCHVO z.s. member's ownership. Dogs in Czech citizens' ownership with permanent residence in Czechia, must be registered in ČMKU studbook. Dogs excluded from the show: Dogs or bitches which are ill, suspected of illness or after an injury, bitches in second half of pregnancy, lactating or in season, also dogs or bitches in ownership of a person banned from showing dogs, dogs who bite and are aggressive towards people and dogs. Submitting the entry form, exhibitor agrees with publishing their name in the show catalogue and processing their personal data provided to the organizer for period of one year.

Entries: Every dog has to have their own entry form. Illegible or incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Considering classes, age of the dog on the day of the show is determinative. Other conditions have to be met on the day of entry. Dog can only be entered in one class. Changing classes after entering is not possible. Dog in coownership cannot be entered as a second dog for lower price even though one of its owners is also an owner of first entered dog. Such a dog is considered as a dog of different ownership, and therefore the entry fee is for the first entered dog.

Only entries via online system www.dogoffice.cz are accepted.

The organizer is not responsible for incorrectly completed entry forms, nor is he responsible for entry forms not delivered. Organizer is not obliged to notify exhibitor of missing documents or data. Foreign exhibitors may pay the entry fee at the show, though they will be charged the amount of the second entry. Entry fee has to be paid by 9 a.m. Additional paying for such entry is required in case of not participating at the show as well. Exhibitors will be sent a confirmation of the entry via email or SMS ca. 10 days prior to the show.

Any decision made by a judge regarding the qualifications, awards and placing is final and indisputable. However, complaints about the organization of the show and about the procedure followed to give the qualifications, awards and placements are admissible and have to be made immediately in writing to the complaint committee of the show, followed by the immediate deposit of twice the first entry fee, as surety, by the end of judging. If the complaint is found to be unjustified, the surety will be kept by the organiser.

Veterinary regulations: Only clinically healthy animals are admitted to the show. Dogs that do not pass the veterinary check-up are not allowed to participate in the show. All dogs at the show need to have a pet passport or vaccination card and valid rabies vaccine in accordance with s 7 4 par. 1, art. f) of local veterinary law and they have to be immune to canine distemper, parvovirus and leptospirosis. Dogs from EU and third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and need to meet the veterinary rules by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26 May, 2003.
